(Directions: Trenton to Somesville to/through Southwest Harbor on Rt. 102/Main Street; Right onto Rt. 102 at the intersection of Rt. 102 and Rt. 102A; Past Gott's Store; Continue to the intersection of Rt. 102A and Rt. 102; Bear left onto Rt. 102A keeping the convenience store on your right; Proceed less than 0.10 miles on Rt. 102A to the paved entrance to the town office located on the left; Follow the signs up around the town office to the collection site.)

**Please get in line and stay in your vehicle at all times. Trained attendants will unload materials for you.  
Be prepared to provide proof of town in which you reside.**

**If in doubt about a material, bring it and ask if we can accept it!!**

This form entitles a resident from the Towns of: Cranberry Isles, Frenchboro, Lamoine, Mount Desert, Southwest Harbor, Tremont, Trenton, and Swans Island to bring no more than 10 gallons or 40 pounds of household hazardous waste (HHW) or universal waste (UW) to the collection scheduled above **at no charge** except console TV's. The same applies for Bar Harbor residents **EXCEPT** Bar Harbor residents **are not** allowed to dispose of UW for free – they are directed to their own UW site at the Bar Harbor recycling center.

Additional material beyond the 10 gallons or 40 pounds can be disposed of for a fee determined by the amount of materials. The fee schedule for console TV's and additional material will be available at the collection site. Payment must be made on site: checks payable to the Acadia Disposal District. ADD and its vendors reserve the right to refuse material at their discretion.

- When possible, materials should be in original containers and sealed with labels still attached. Otherwise, close securely and clearly mark with name of contents.
- Transport the materials to the site in a cardboard box (we will recycle the cardboard if you do not want it).
